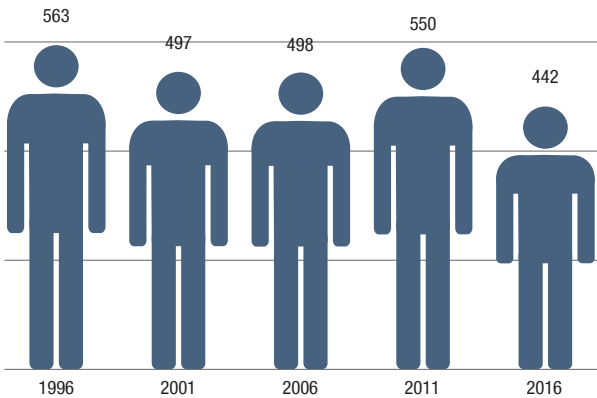


WABOWDEN

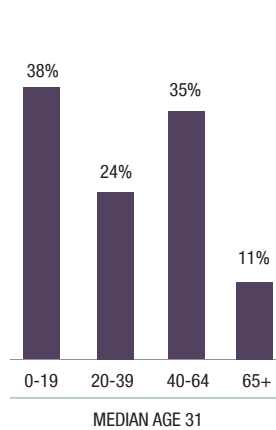
POPULATION CHANGE

2016 Median Age = 31



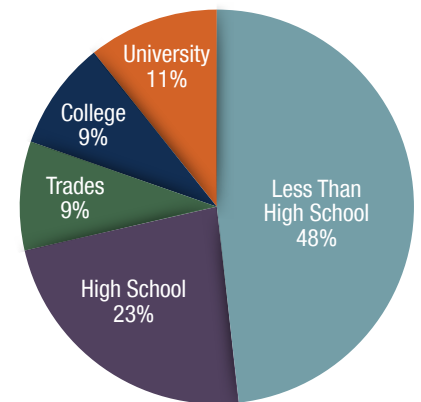
POPULATION BY AGE

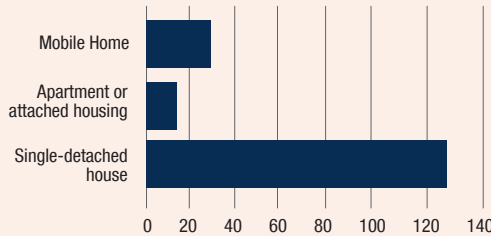

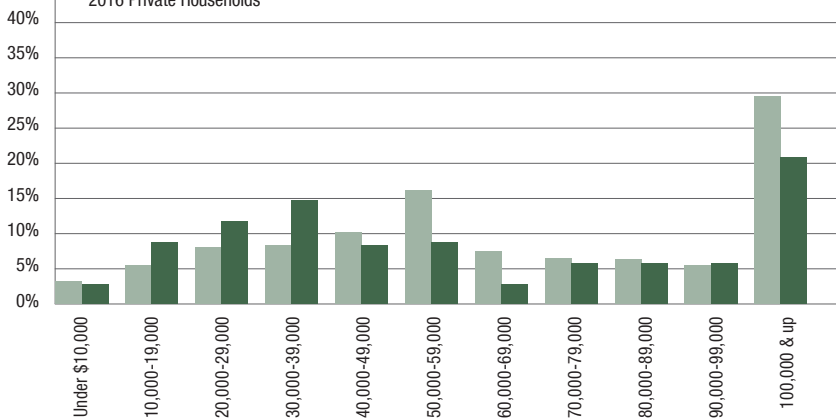

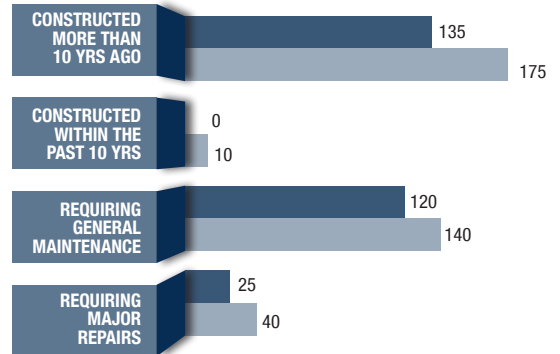

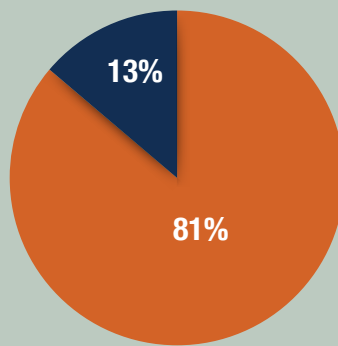
GROWING INDUSTRIES

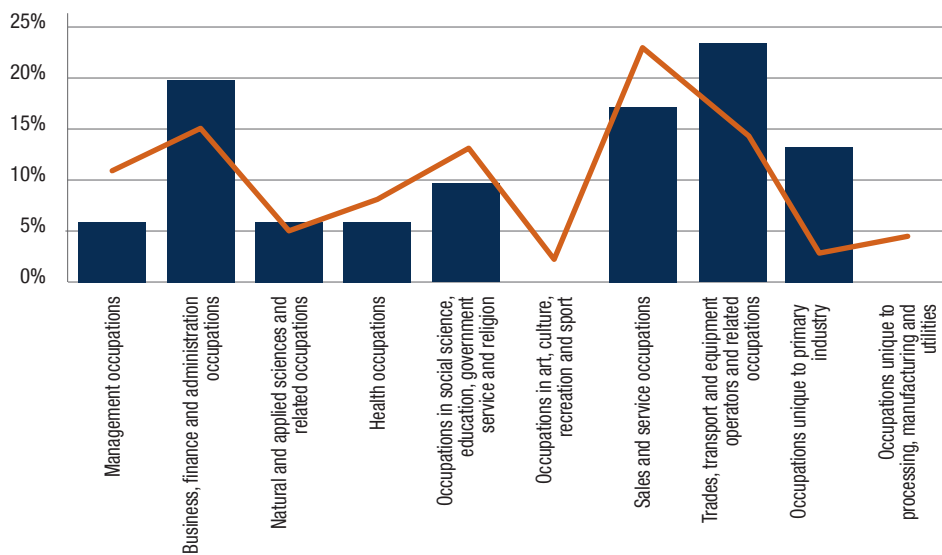

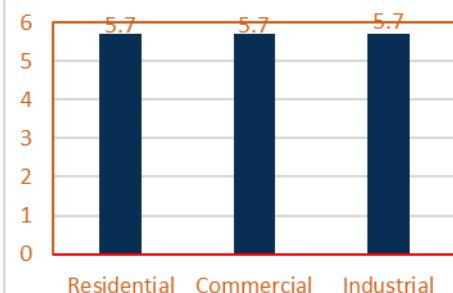
