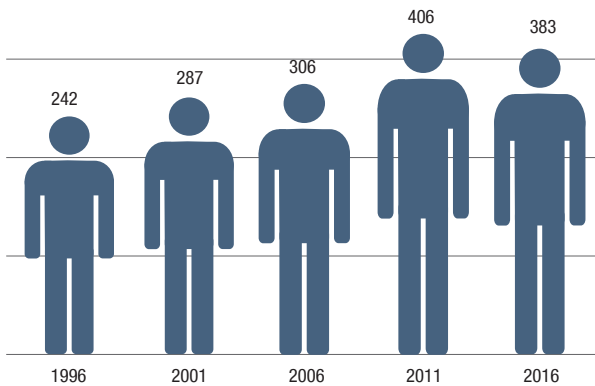


BARREN LANDS

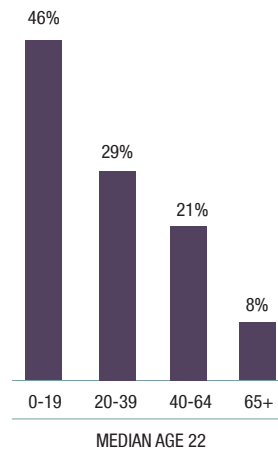
POPULATION CHANGE

2016 Median Age = 22



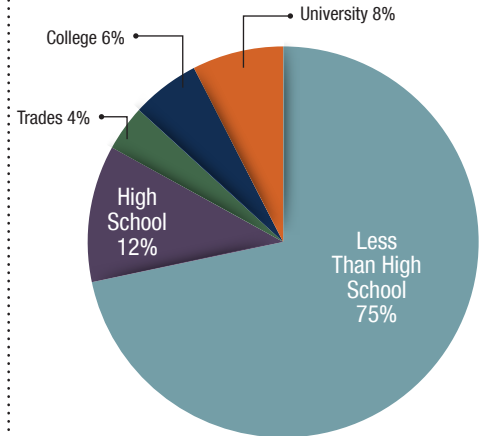
POPULATION BY AGE

2016 total population 15 year and over - 255

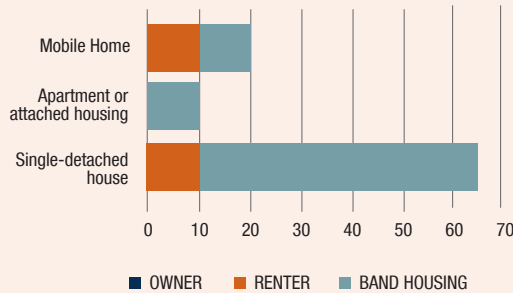

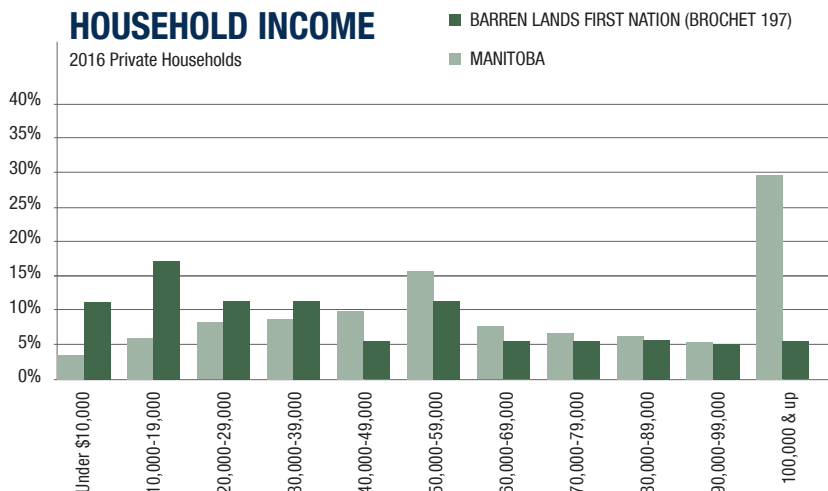

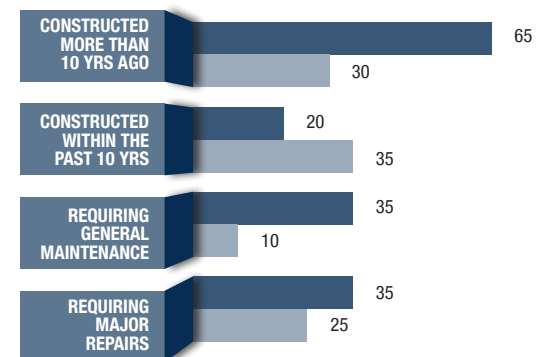


HOUSEHOLD INCOME

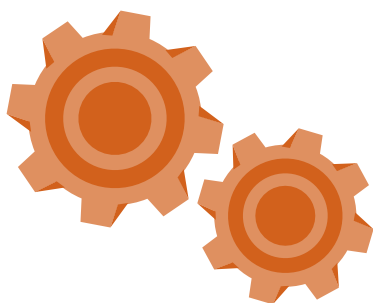

(GROWTH OF OVER 10 JOBS FROM 2006-2016)

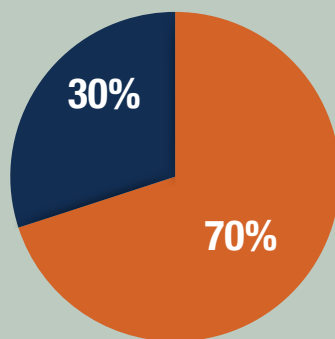

Population 15 years and older



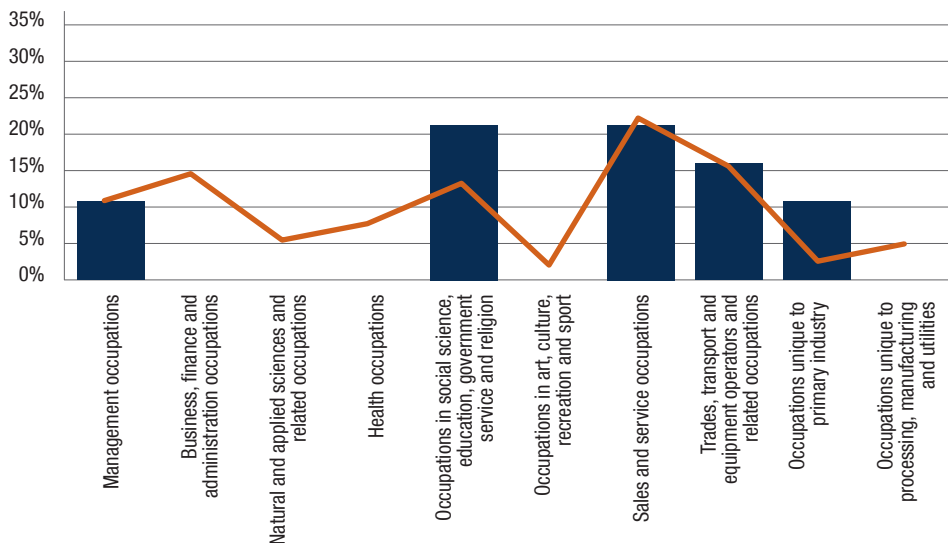
