


BARREN LANDS


POPULATION CHANGE

Since 1996, population has increased by 141 people 2016 Median Age =22




POPULATION BY AGE


2016 total population 15 year and over - 255








GROWING INDUSTRIES






LABOUR FORCE BY OCCUPATION
