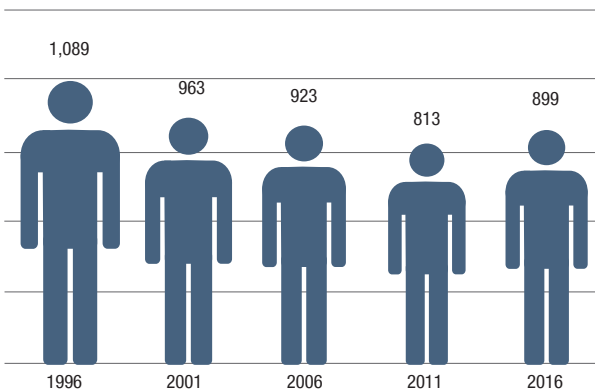


CHURCHILL

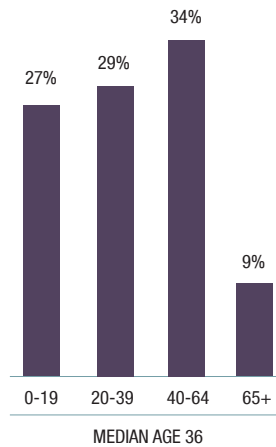
POPULATION CHANGE

2016 Median Age = 36



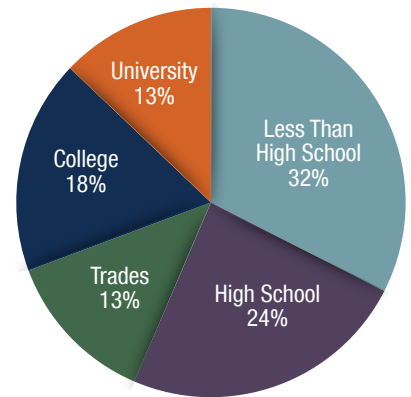
POPULATION BY AGE

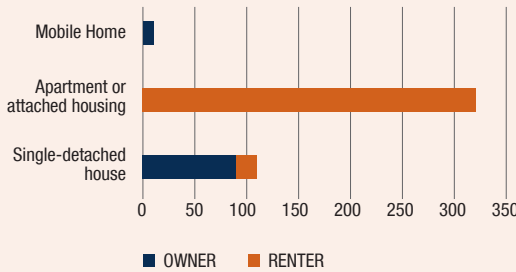

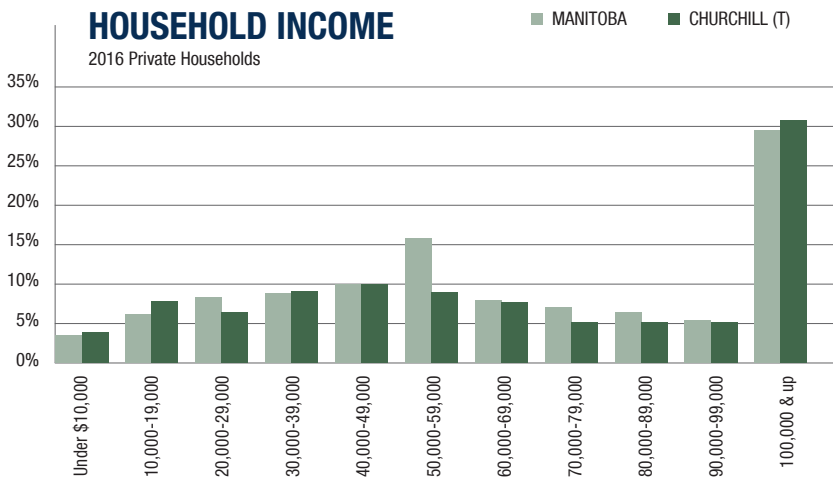

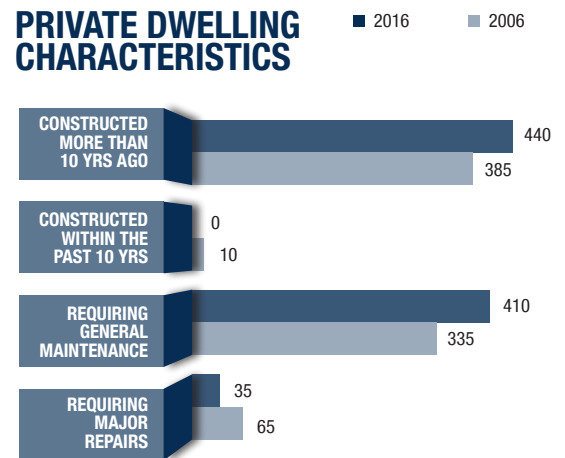


HOUSEHOLD INCOME

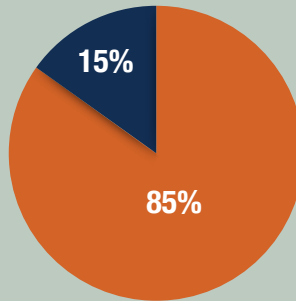
GROWING INDUSTRIES

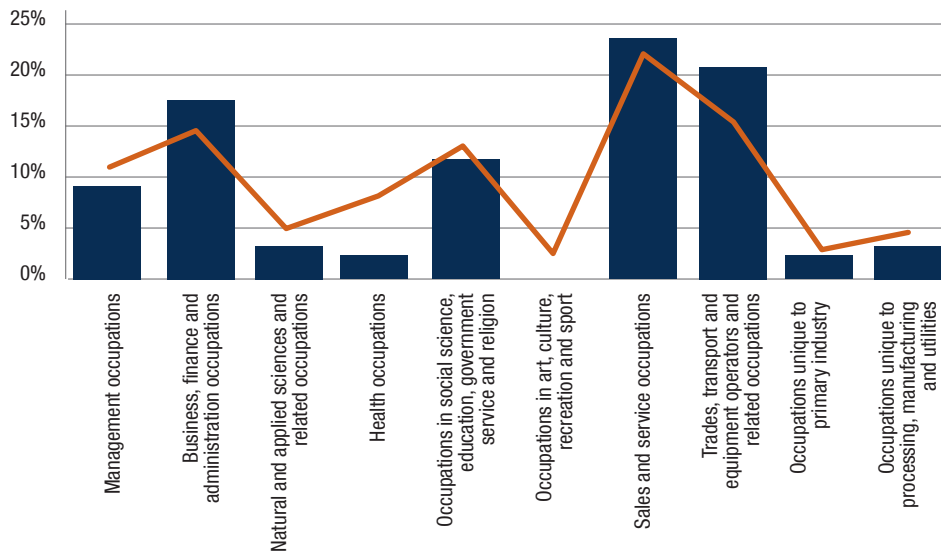

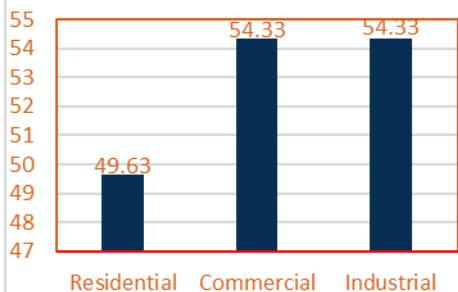
