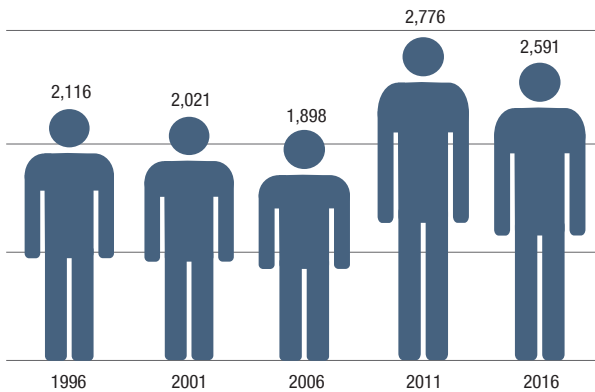


# GARDEN HILL

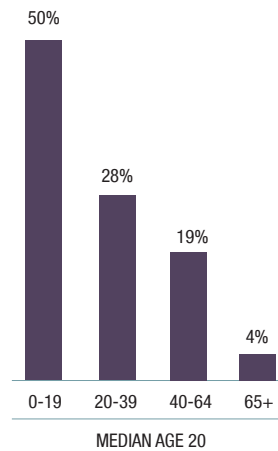
## POPULATION CHANGE

2016 Median Age = 20



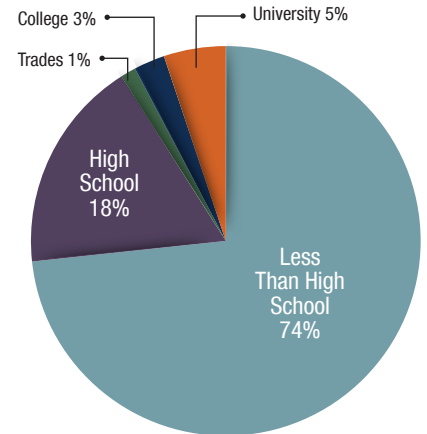
## POPULATION BY AGE

2016 total population 15 year and over - 1550

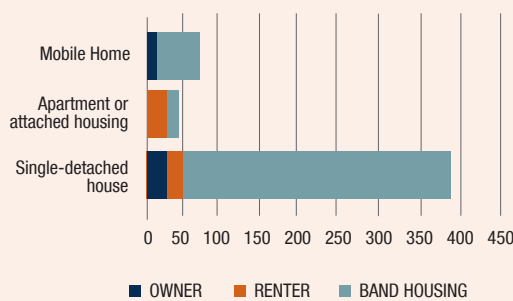

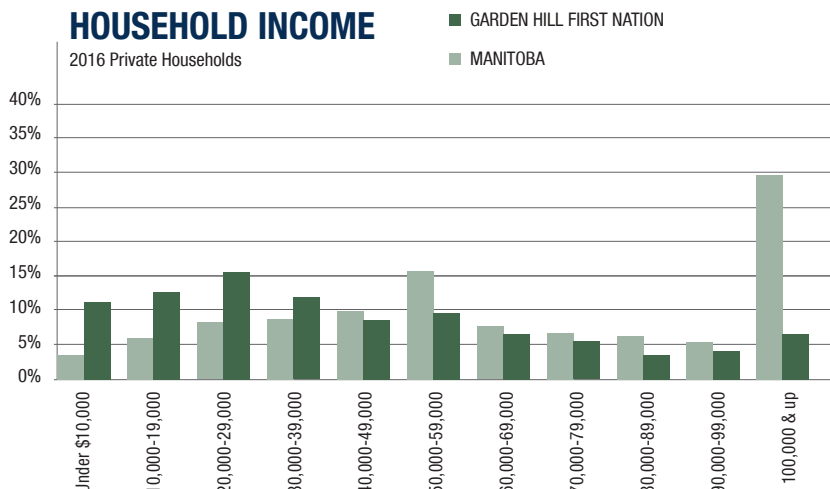

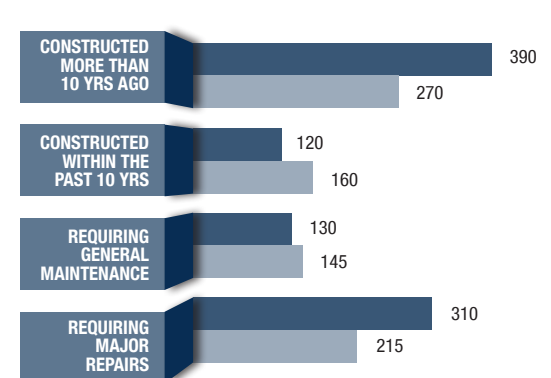


## HOUSEHOLD INCOME

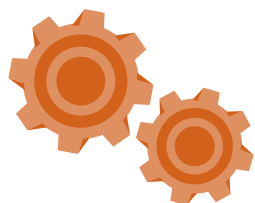

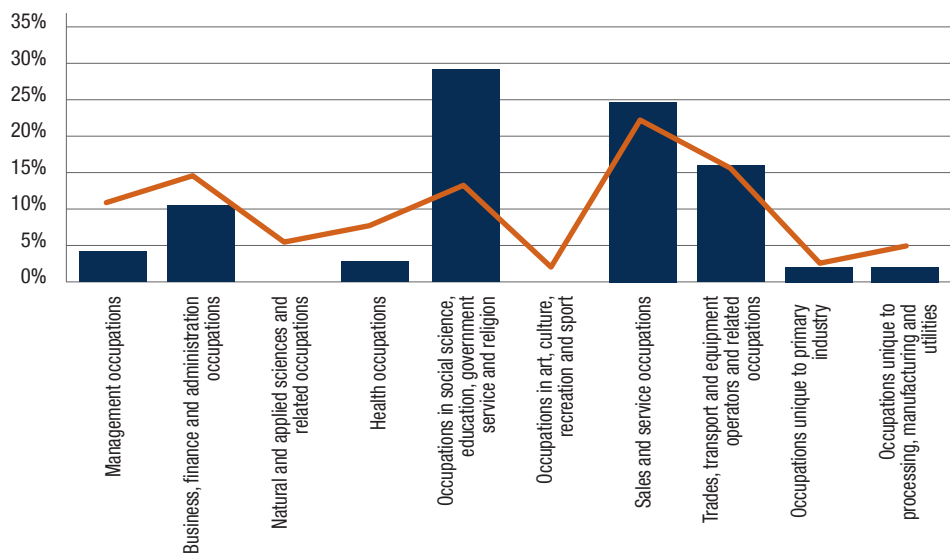
