


PUKATAWAGAN

Pukatawagan also known as Mathias Colomb is an indigenous Cree community with traditional territory covering much of northwestern Manitoba. It can be reached by rail, air or winter roads from The Pas. Pukatawagan is a Cree word meaning "fishing place": or "fishing with a net".


POPULATION CHANGE

Since 1996, population has increased by 523 people (NET POPULATION)




POPULATION BY AGE


2016 total population 15 year and over - 1,050








