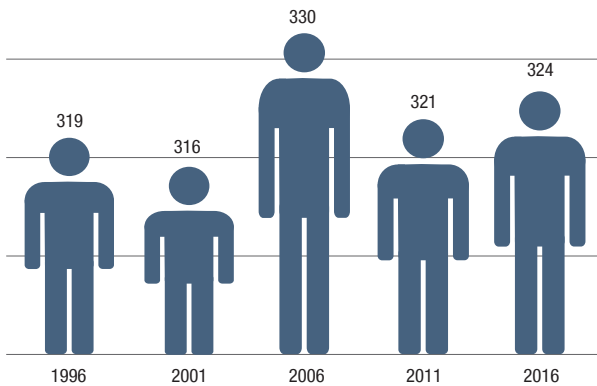


SAYISI DENE

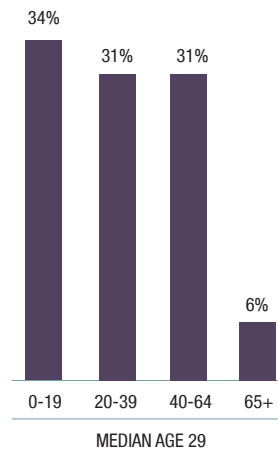
POPULATION CHANGE

2016 Median Age = 29



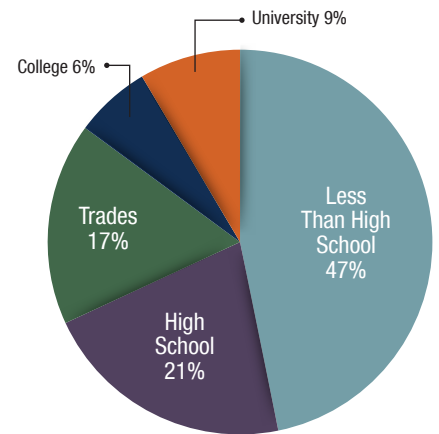
POPULATION BY AGE

2016 total population 15 year and over - 235

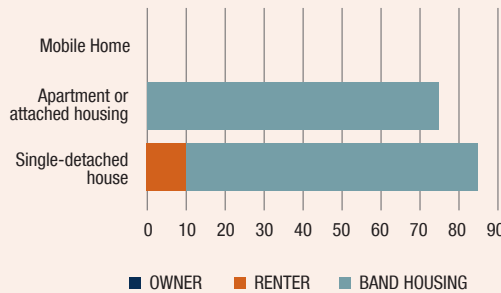

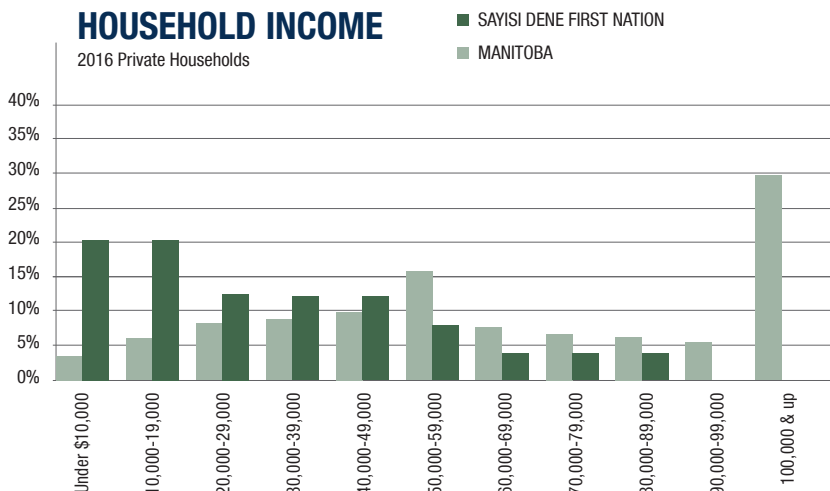

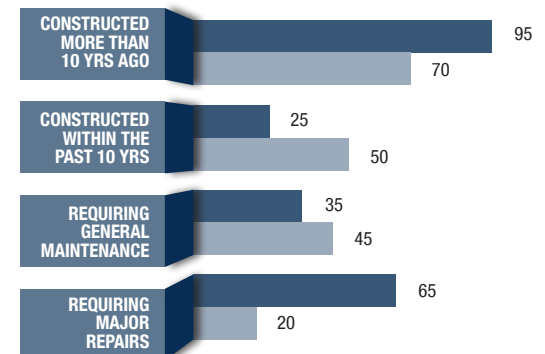


HOUSEHOLD INCOME

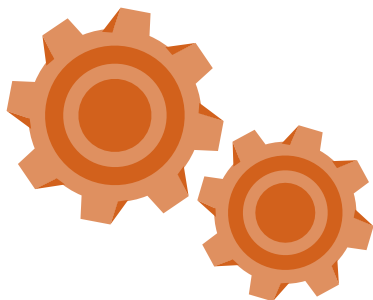

(GROWTH OF OVER 10 JOBS FROM 2006-2016)

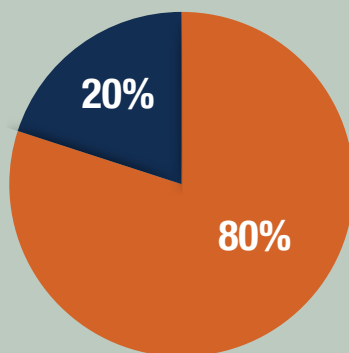

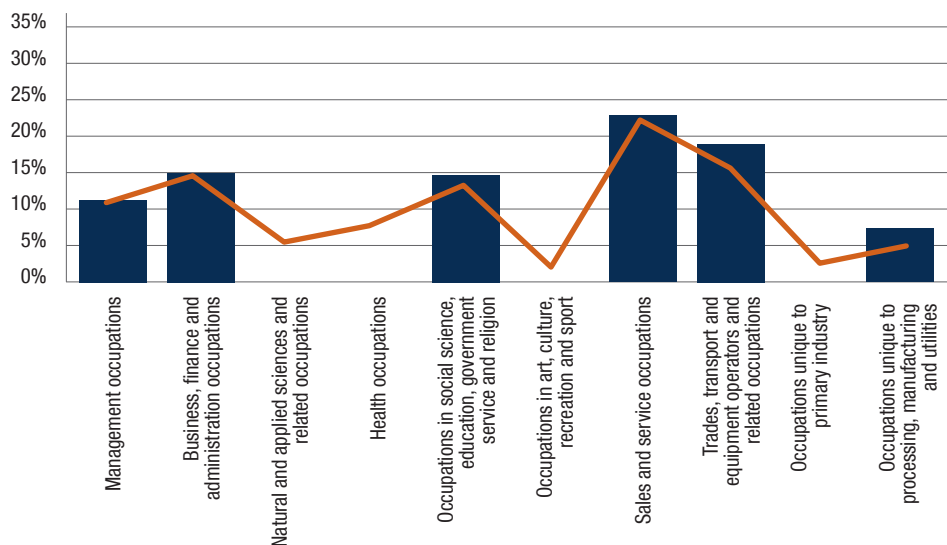
