
# WABOWDEN


## POPULATION CHANGE

Since 1996, population has decreased by 121 people. 2016 Median Age = 31




## POPULATION BY AGE

2016 total population 15 year and over - 280




**MEDIAN MONTHLY SHELTER COSTS** 2016 - OWNED DWELLING










## LABOUR FORCE BY OCCUPATION




