


# WAR LAKE

Since 1996, population has decreased by 49 people 2016 Median Age =33



2016 total population



2016 total population 15 year and over - 70







FAMILIES IN PRIVATE HOUSEHOLDS 25


AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD SIZE ?








## LABOUR FORCE BY OCCUPATION
