

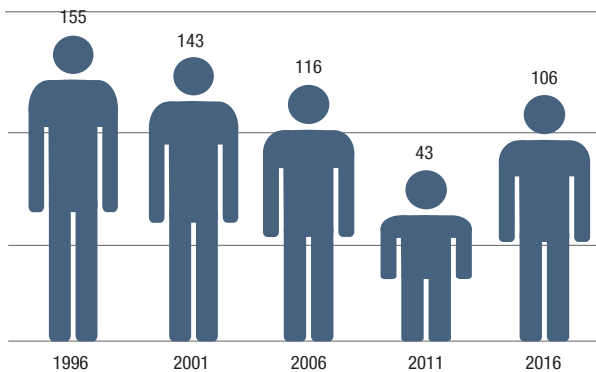
WAR LAKE

War Lake First Nation (Moosecoot) is situated at Ilford. This region was settled during the construction of the Hudson Bay Railway in the early 1900's. Long time chief Betsy Kennedy received the Order of Manitoba in 2016 for her important contributions to the community.

2016 Median Age = 33

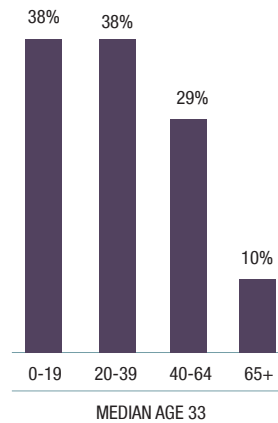

2016 total population

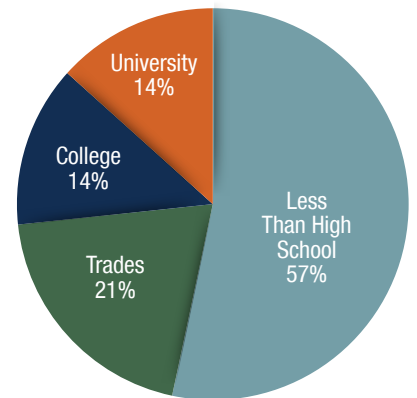

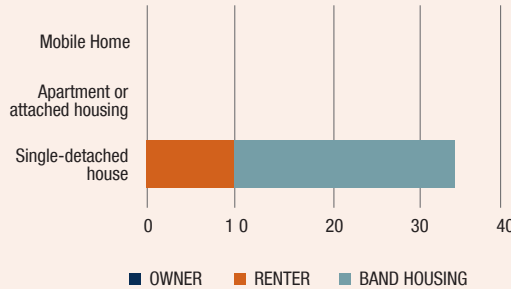

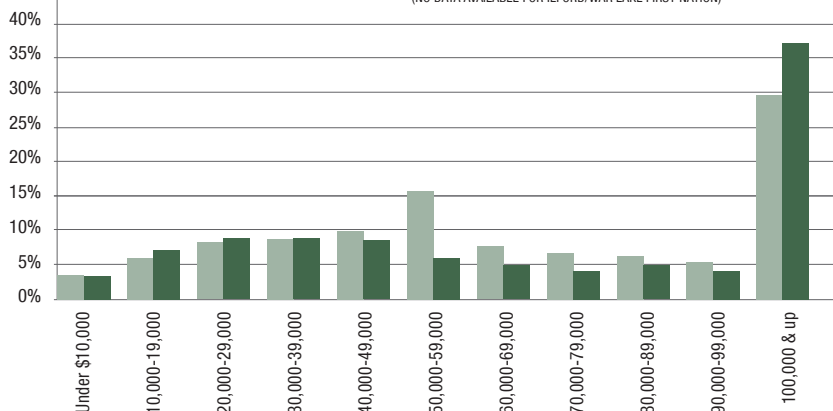

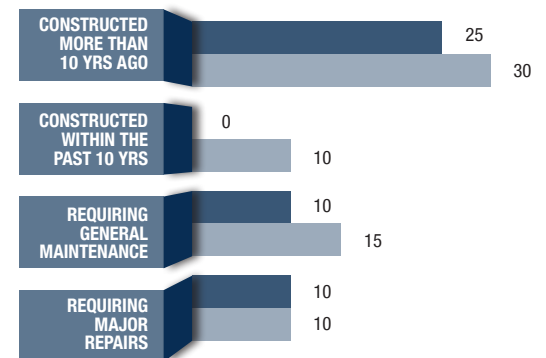

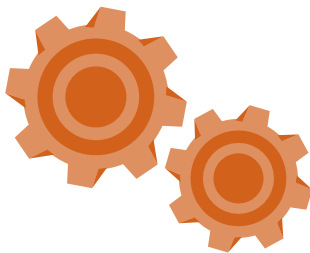

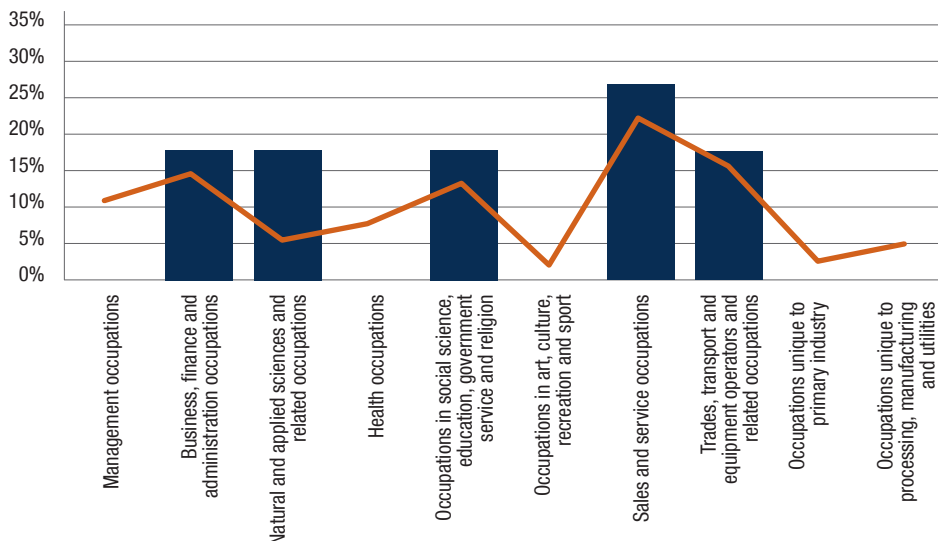
