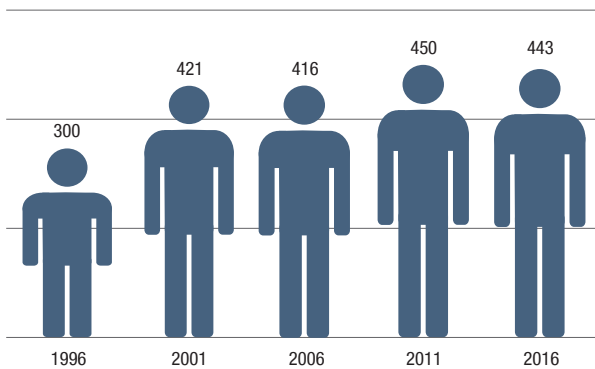


# YORK FACTORY

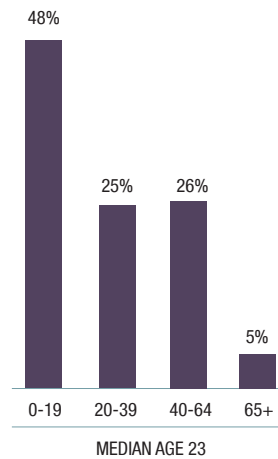
## POPULATION CHANGE

2016 Median Age = 23



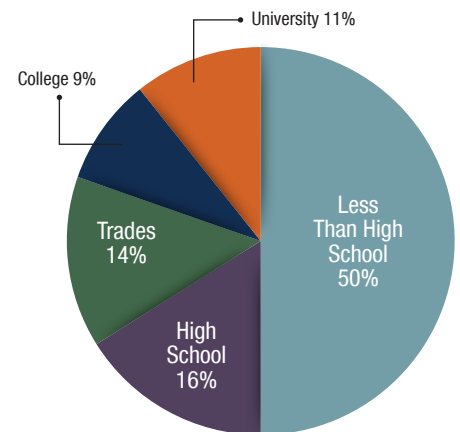
## POPULATION BY AGE

2016 total population 15 year and over - 280

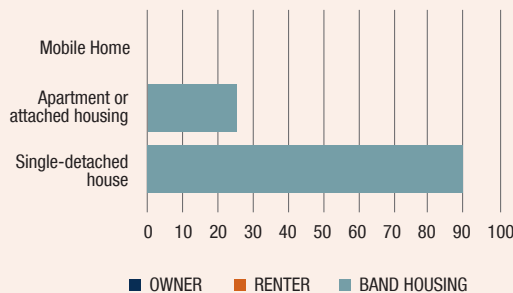

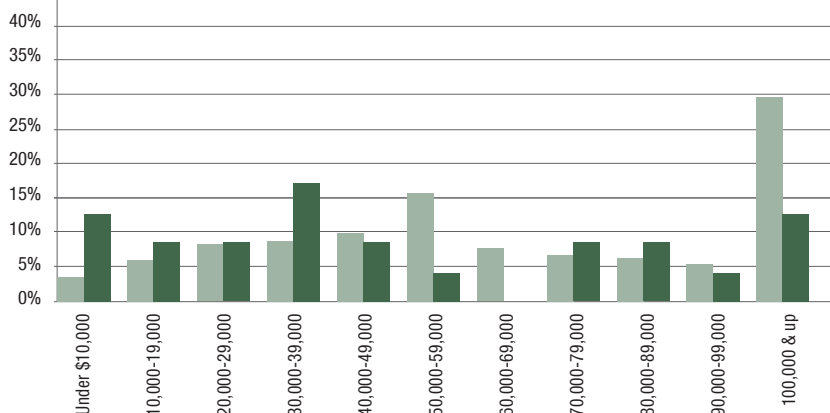

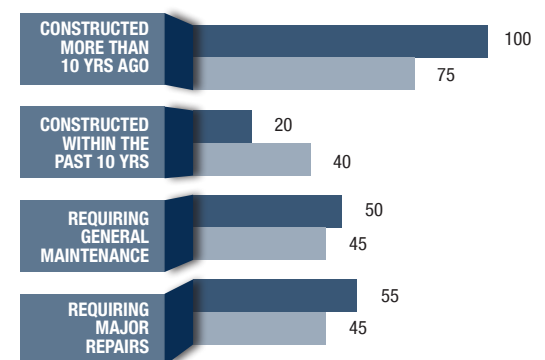

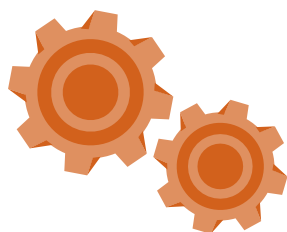

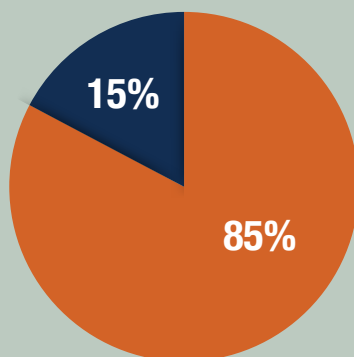

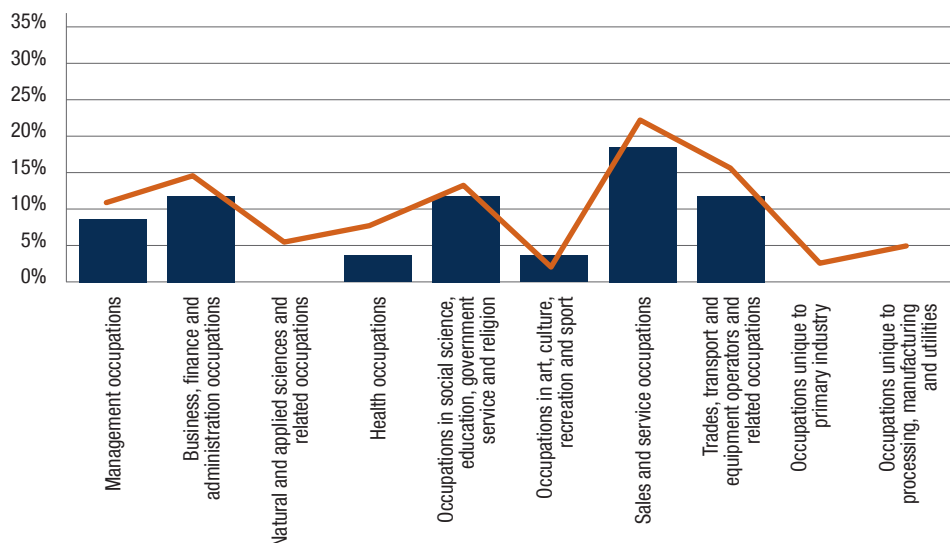
